



Rogers-Lowell Area Chamber of Commerce: Quick Facts

- There are more than 7,000 chambers of commerce in the United States, and approximately 350 are accredited – a system of chamber standards and best practices.
- Of the accredited chambers, only 44 have achieved Five Star Accreditation from the United States Chamber of Commerce, the highest honor available to a chamber. We were one of the first twenty in the nation to achieve Five Stars and are the only Five Star Accredited chamber of commerce in the state of Arkansas.



- The Rogers-Lowell Area Chamber of Commerce has more than 2,100 member businesses with more than 4,200 individual representatives.
- In October 2008, the Arkansas Business Journal named the Rogers-Lowell Area Chamber of Commerce the largest chamber in Arkansas, exceeding cities such as Little Rock, Fort Smith and Jonesboro despite their larger population base.
- We are the voice of business – we bring the community together, work behind the scenes for the greater good and do the things most people think “just happen.”
- The 23 professional staff of the Rogers-Lowell Area Chamber of Commerce, guided by our Board of Directors, oversee more than 30 committees and administer more than 40 programs resulting in nearly 200 annual events.
- We impact the community through programs devoted to small business outreach, economic development, workforce recruitment and retention, government affairs, destination marketing, education, drug-free and healthy communities, quality of life, leadership development and long-range community strategic planning.
